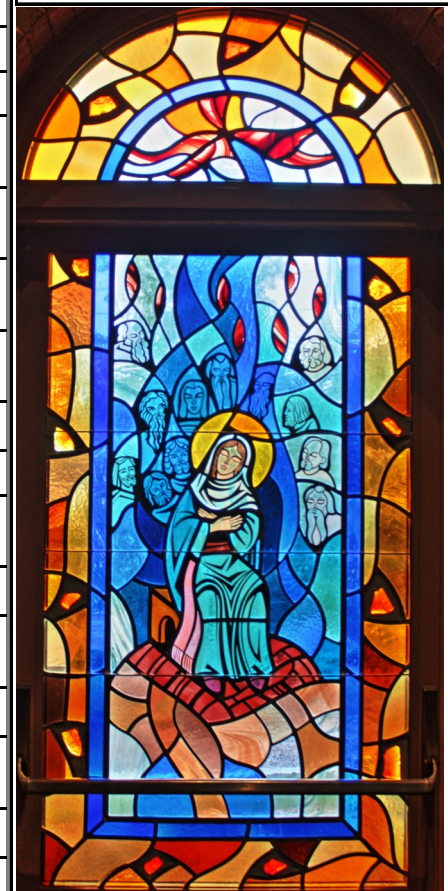

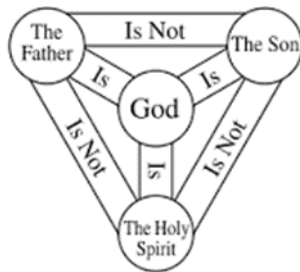

Deacon's Teaching By Deacon Chris Christopher Pentecost – Decent of the Holy Spirit

The Feast of Pentecost commemorates the day when the Holy Spirit descended upon the Church, and the disciples, in Jerusalem after Jesus's resurrection. It is referred to as the birthday of the Church because from that point on the apostles carried the message of Christ to the whole world and ushered in a new era for the people of God. It is that same Holy Spirit we receive in baptism and confirmation. And the same mission of those first disciples also applies to us.

To get a fuller understanding of who God is, one needs to understand **all** of who God is. Knowing the difference between God the Father and Jesus Christ is one thing, but many struggle to grasp who or what the Holy Spirit is and His role in our lives, hence, the importance of the Feast of Pentecost.



Scripture tells us that the Holy Spirit existed right from the beginning, *"Now the earth was formless and empty, darkness was over the surface of the deep, and the Spirit of God was hovering over the waters."* (Genesis 1:2)

Like God the Father and God the Son, The Holy Spirit is not just an influence but a distinct personality. As a person, He can be grieved as St. Paul tells us, *"And do not grieve the Holy Spirit of God, with whom*

you were sealed for the day of redemption." (Ephesians 4:30)

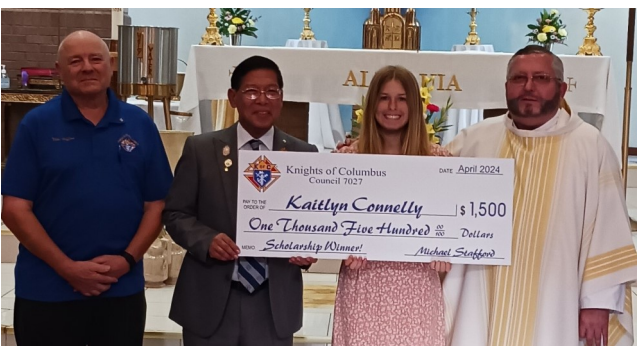
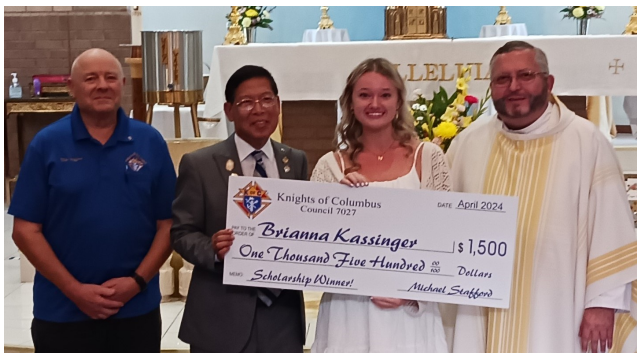
Understanding who the Holy Spirit is, the place He holds within the Trinity, and the role He plays in our lives, is vital to those who wish to become better Christians. For example: When we pray or read the Bible and sense God speaking to us, it is the Holy Spirit at work in our lives. When we get up in the morning, we pray to the Holy Spirit to guide us through the day. The more we know about the Holy Spirit, the easier it will be to give Him the recognition He deserves in our lives.

Jesus left us the sacraments through which the Holy Spirit conveys these graces of God. Jesus told us He had to leave this earth so that the paraclete/ advocate/counselor could come to guide us and be with us just as He had; that person is the Holy Spirit (Gospel of John 14:16, 14:26, 15:26, 16:7, and First Epistle of John chapter 2, verse 1).

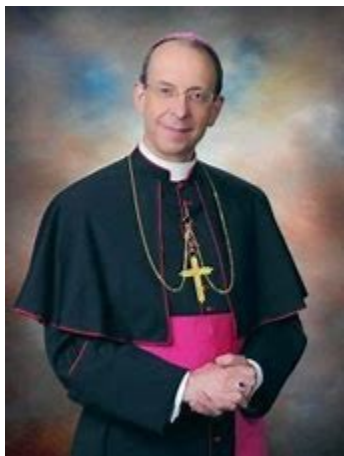
St. Paul says: *"Since the Spirit is our life, let us be directed by the Spirit"* (Galatians 5:25). St. Augustine taught that the Holy Spirit is the soul of the Church, and as the soul gives life to the body, so also the Spirit gives life to the Church.

Understanding the significance of Pentecost should help us grow in holiness. Let us pray to the Holy Spirit to guide us and help us become more aware of his presence in our lives.

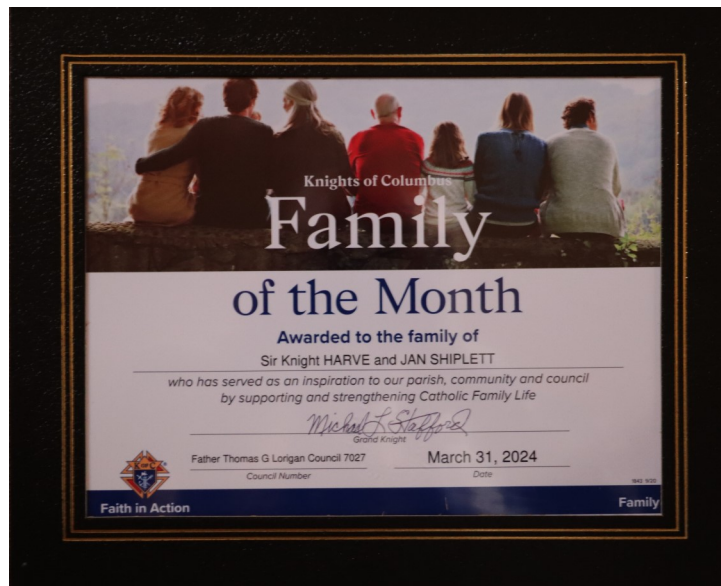

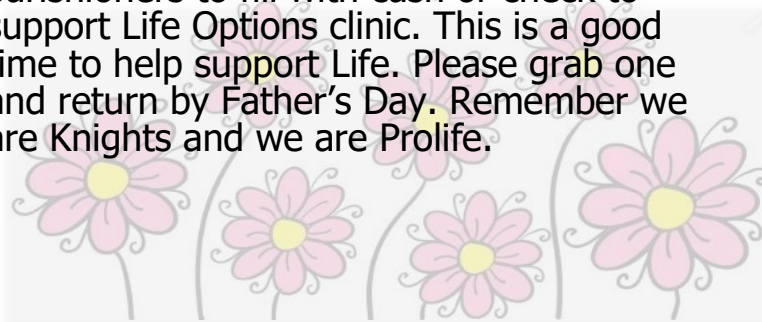
